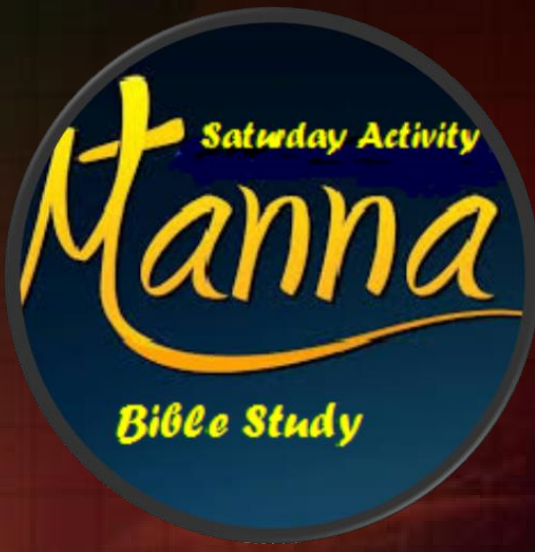




Manna Bible Study

What is Manna Bible Study?

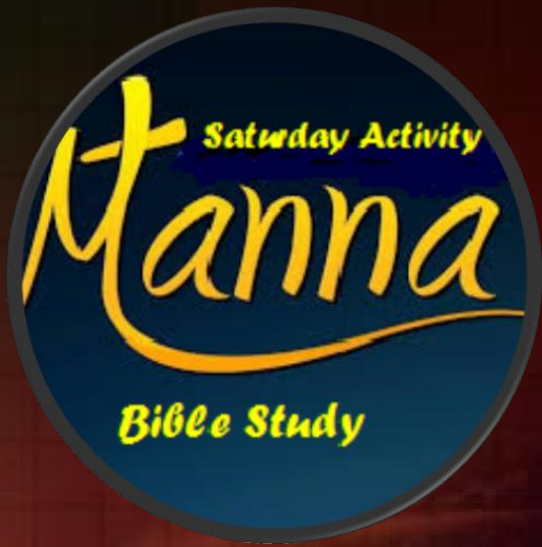

This Curriculum contains three main topics

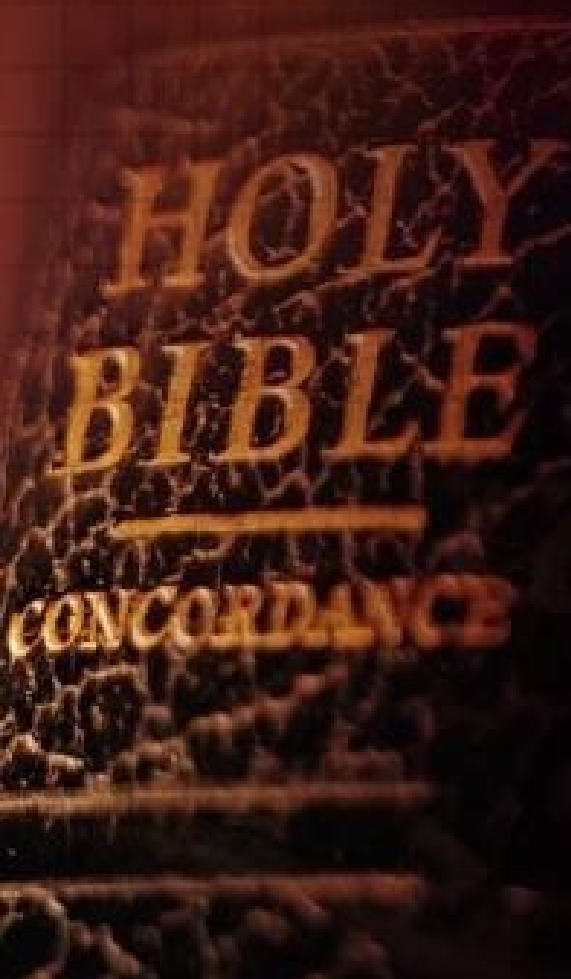
- **Bible study:** The Holy Bible is core element of the curriculum.

- **Memorization.**



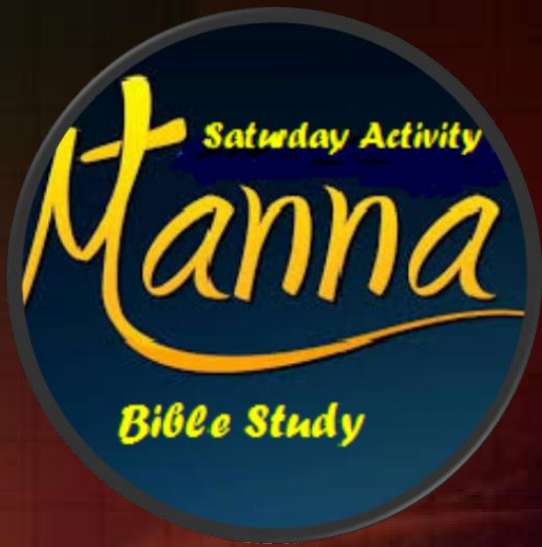
1. Bible Study

Children will learn how to read God's Word carefully, interpret it according to church fathers, and apply what we know in our 21st-century lives. We divided the Holy Bible lessons into 4 grades from grade 3 to grade 6



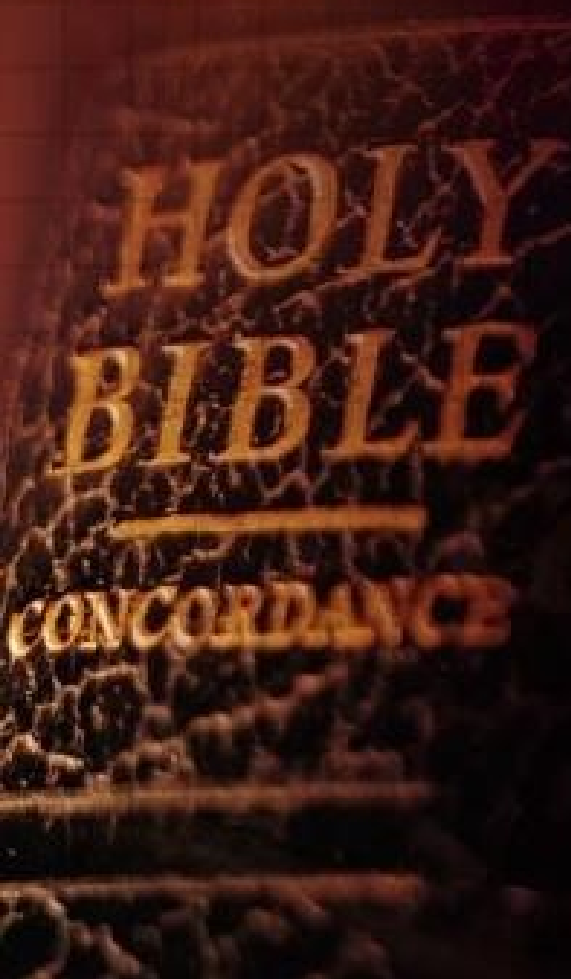

What does each lesson contain?

Each Bible lesson contains an exciting lessons and classroom discussion to engage the children in each lesson inside the classroom. Each lesson also has Family Devotions to read it with your children at home.





Family Devotions

Family devotions are Biblical lessons you will receive it throughout the week. It is 5 days devotional from Monday to Friday. They are designed to provide families with quick and powerful daily devotions on the same Bible lesson that was taught in the Manna program during Saturday Activity. It helps parents to follow up and help their kids to grow together in Christ as one body. It only takes a few minutes each day to read with your children and walk them in God's truth.





2- Ritual of our Coptic Orthodox (Our Beliefs)

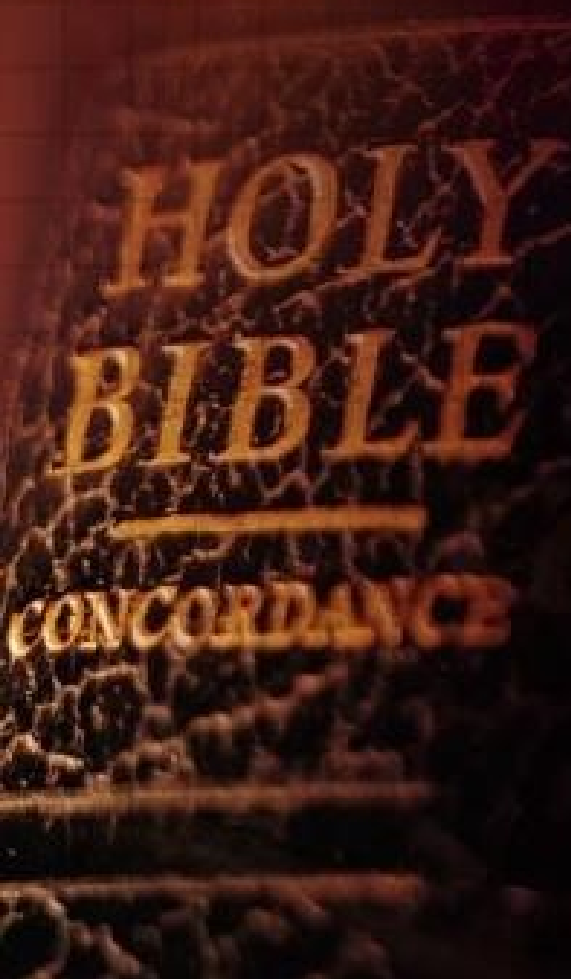

Raising of incense

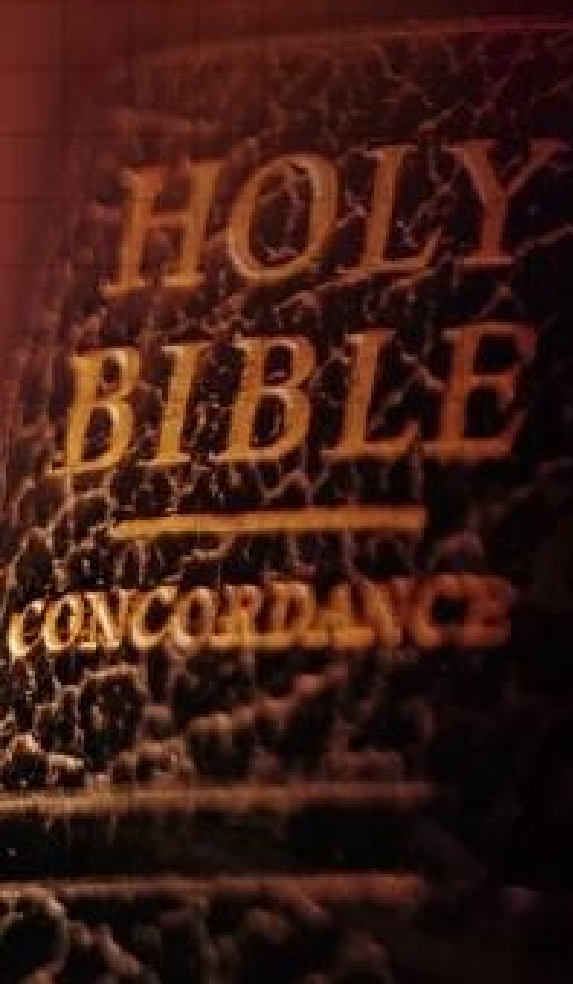

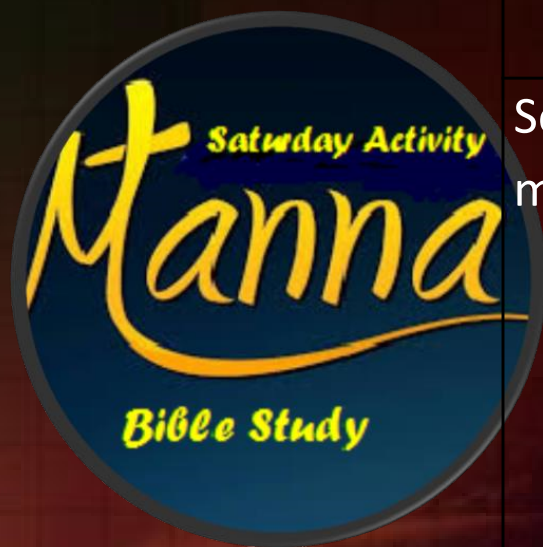




3- Memorization:

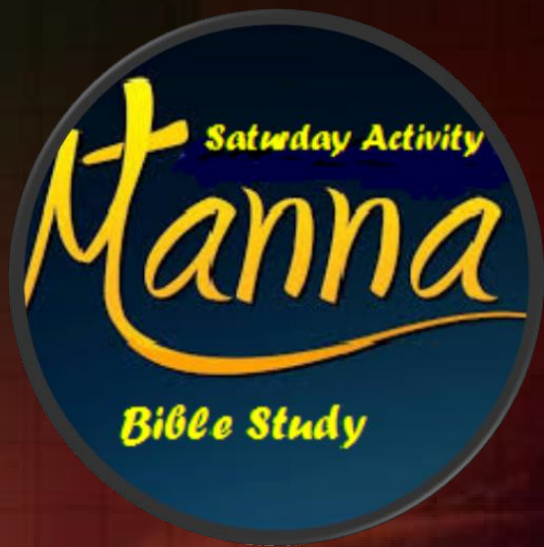

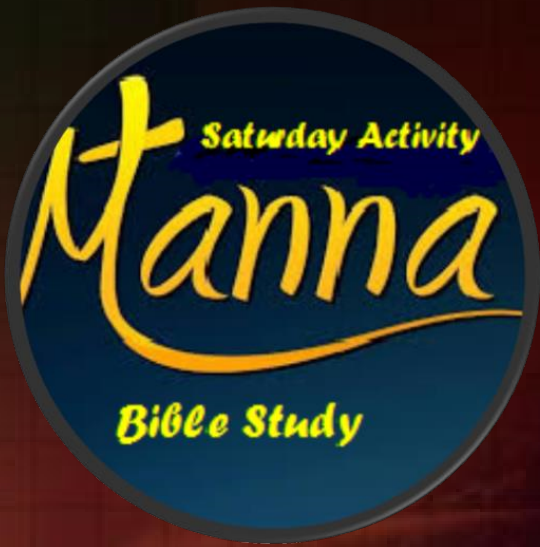
