What is Manna Bible Study?



What does this anna curriculum contain?


This Curriculum contains three main topics

- Memorization.




1.Bible Study




What does each lesson contain?


Family Devotions

2- Ritual of our Coptic Orthodox (Our Beliefs)





3- Memorization:




Google classroom


