Roles and Responsibilities

All servants have a responsibility for their own spiritual lives to be committed to its growth through the sacraments of the church, through attendance of spiritual meetings and retreats.

All aspire to have a spirit of discipleship, prayer, humility, seriousness, introspection, fellowship and adherence to the commandments. Through these we may be able to spiritually lead our children to a life with our Lord Jesus Christ.

Roles and Responsibilities of the Lead Servant

1- To Welcome others:

"Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness, and hold such men in esteem;" (Phil 2:29)

- A- Looks after general well-being of children and servants in his/her class.
- B- Outreaches children and servants

2- To Organize:

"But all things must be done properly and in an orderly manner.." (1 Corinthians 14:40)

- A. Mentors servants by being a role model.
- B. Addresses concerns and issues of servants and parents
- C. Sets up monthly class meetings.
- D. Checks lessons of servants and general adherence to the set curriculum
- E. Follows up with teachers regarding their responsibilities
- F. Delegates responsibilities as sees fit

3- To Submit

"Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you." (Hebrews 13:17)
