You need your bible.

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
Read (Matthew 6:19-21)





Adventure 4: Read Matthew 6:28-30


Find the words that complete this verse.

Unscramble each of the clue words. Take the letters that appear in the circle boxes and unscramble them to find the answer to the last phrase.


