


### Palm Sunday





# Eve of Wednesday



Then Mary took about a pint of pure nard, an expensive perfume; she poured it on Jesus' feet and wiped his feet with her hair. John 12:3 (NIV)



### Great Thursday

On this day, Jesus and His disciples went to an upper room to prepare for the Passover. In preparation for the Passover, Jesus tied a towel around His waist, kneeled down and washed the feet of every disciples. When it was Peter's turn, he tried to stop the Lord from doing this. Jesus told him in order for you to enter the kingdom of heaven, one must be cleaned first. Washing of the feet represents our repentance.

On this day also, Jesus established the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist after the Last Supper, when He gave His pure Body and precious Blood to His disciples in the form of bread and wine. After the Eucharist, Christ talked to His disciples about His death that would happen soon. He reminded them of all His deeds, words, and miracles He did when He was with them.

After talking with His disciples, Jesus went to the garden of Gethsemane and began to pray to His Father in heaven to give Him strength for the things that were about to begin. During this prayer, we see Christ's pain for the spiritual and physical suffering that were to come. He prayed to His Father in heaven saying, "Your will be done," even though He knew it would be very hard.

Once Jesus was done praying and returned from the garden, Judas met Jesus and betrayed Him with a Kiss. The guards that were watching Judas immediately came and took Jesus to the high priest, and His trials began.

#### Memory Verse:




# Eve of Friday

On this eve, the trials of Jesus began. Three trials were held in front of the Jews. During these trials, they brought in false witness against Him, spat on Him, and slapped Him. When they could not find anything against Him, one came and said that He claimed Himself to be the son of the Most High. When the high priest asked Jesus about it, He confirmed it, and the high priest tore his service garment. That was a sign of the end of the Old Testament priesthood.

While all of this was happening, Peter was outside watching. Someone asked him if he was one of Jesus' disciples, and Peter, being afraid, answered and said he never knew Jesus. This happened three times, and the third time Peter denied Christ, a rooster crowed just as Jesus had warned Peter would happen the day before. When Peter remembered Jesus' words, he was very troubled and wept bitterly because he had not been faithful to Christ.

# Good Friday


On this day, the trials of Jesus continued. Jesus stood before Roman governors three times: once in front of Pilate, then Herod, and finally back to Pilate The first time, Pilate saw nothing wrong with Jesus, so he sent Him to Herod. Herod wanted to see Jesus do a miracle. When Jesus did not do one, Herod mocked Him and put a scarlet robe on Him and sent Him back to Pilate. Again, Pilate could not see anything wrong with Jesus, so he decided to show Him to the people and asked them what they wanted.

A criminal named Barabbas, who was a robber, was presented with Jesus. Pilate asked the people to choose who they wanted to crucify. The high priest convinced the people to cry out with a loud voice saying, "Crucify Jesus!" over and over again. Finally, Pilate gave the people what they wanted, to crucify Jesus.

Pílate ordered Jesus to be whípped. Roman soldiers put a crown of thorns on His head, gave Him a purple robe and saíd "Haíl, King of the Jews!" They also slapped Him and brought Him out to the people and mockingly presented Him as a king. After all of this, they made Jesus carry His own cross up the mountain called Golgotha where He was to be crucified.


On the way, Jesus became weak because of all the torture, and He fell on His way up the mountain. The guards told a man named Simon, a Cyrenian, to help Jesus carry the cross. Also, on His way, a woman went to Him weeping and wiped His face. He told her, "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for Me, but weep for yourselves and for your children." (Luke 23:28) When Jesus finally got to the top of the mountain, they crucified Him and wrote on the cross. "THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS". Two criminals were crucified with Him. The one on His right cried and said. ""Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom." And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."

At the sixth hour (noon), the sky went dark and Jesus said, "Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit," and He breathed His last breath. After a few hours, a man named Joseph went to Pilate and asked if he could take Jesus' body down to put it in a tomb. Pilate gave him permission, so he took Jesus down from the cross, wrapped His body in linen, and laid it in a tomb.

### Easter Sunday

Jesus rose from the dead, and an angel of the Lord rolled back the stone so that His Resurrection would be discovered. But the guards reported to the chief priests that there was a violent earthquake causing the stone to be rolled away. They paid the soldiers a large sum of money, telling them to say, "His disciples came during the night and stole him away while we were asleep."

At dawn on Sunday, Mary Magdalene and a few women went to the tomb. Mary Magdalene was the first one to get to the tomb. When she was that the stone was rolled away and that the body of Jesus was not there, she began to cry and looked around to see if she could find the body of Christ. While she was looking, she saw an angel who told her, "He is not here; He has risen, just as He said".

Afraid yet filled with joy, the women hurried away from the tomb, and ran to tell his disciples. Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings," He said. They came to Him, collapsed at His feet and worshiped Him. They went and told the other disciples, but they didn't believe.

Peter and John ran to the tomb. John arrived first but didn't enter the tomb. He looked inside and saw the strips of linen lying there. Then Peter came and entered the tomb. He saw the strips of linen lying there, as well as the cloth that had been wrapped around Jesus' head. The cloth was still lying in its place, separate from the linen. When they saw this, they ran to tell the other disciples who were hiding because they were afraid. While they were locked in the room, Jesus Himself appeared to them and said, "Peace to you". They all were terrified and thought it was a ghost. Jesus then asked them,

"Why are you troubled? And why do doubts arise in your hearts? Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have".

Only when they ate together did they realized that it was really Him and they all greatly rejoiced, for Christ had risen!
