Main events:

On the evening of Palm Sunday our Lord went with His disciples outside the city. Along the way to Bethany, Christ was hungry; and He cursed a fig tree which had many leaves but no fruit (1st & 3rd hour).

On the way Jesus taught His disciples Jerusalem. He knew what would happen to Him. He taught them, in the parable of the grain of wheat, *He had to be crucified and buried to bring more fruits and more people to Glory.*

Jesus goes to the temple, where He spends His days during the week. The evenings are spent resting in Bethany (Luke 21:27-38).

Bethany is referred to as the village of Lazarus, Martha and Mary, and is located about 15 minutes from Jerusalem (John 11:18).
