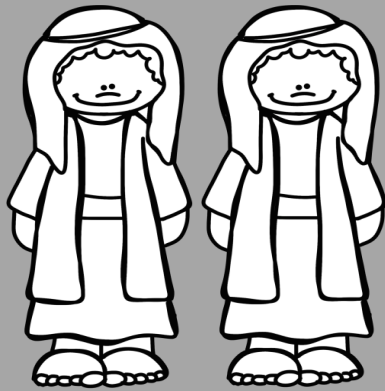


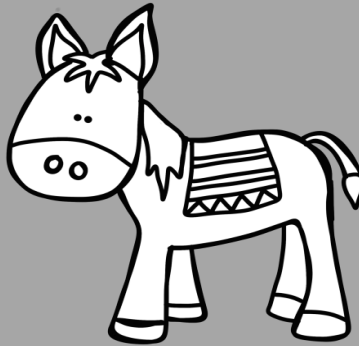

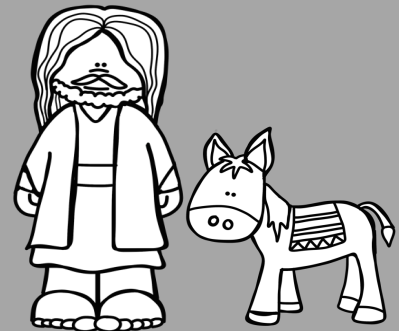

Jesus rode on the donkey.



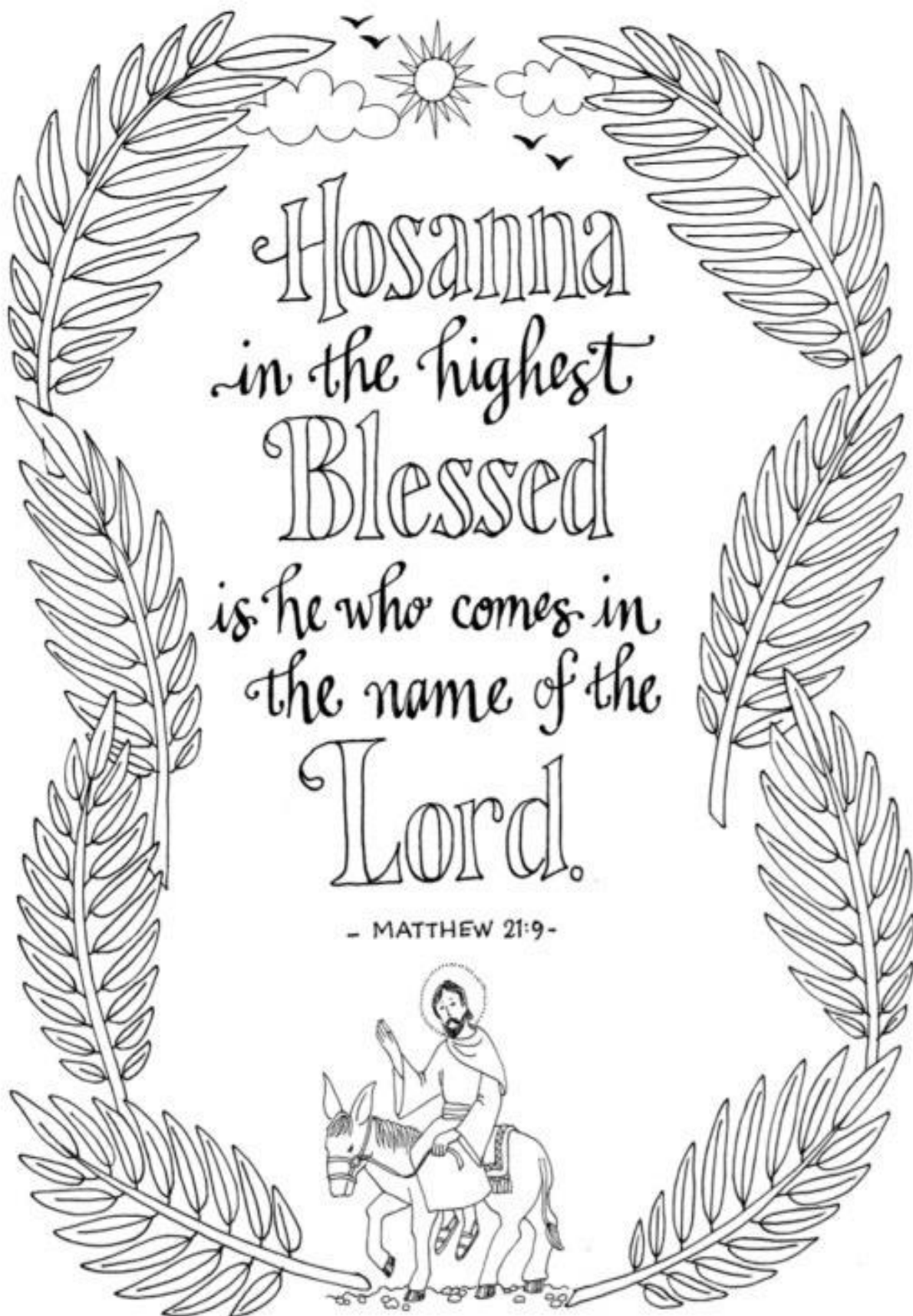

He tipped over the tables and the money went everywhere.



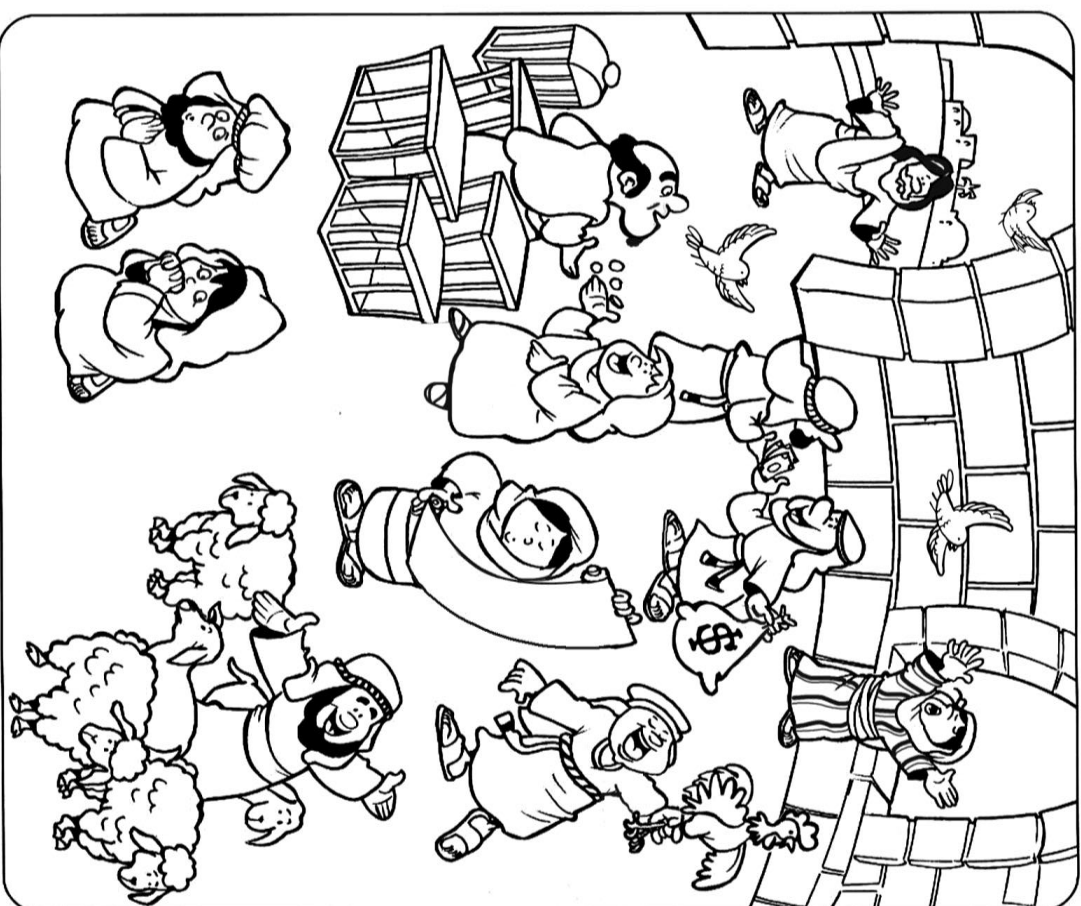
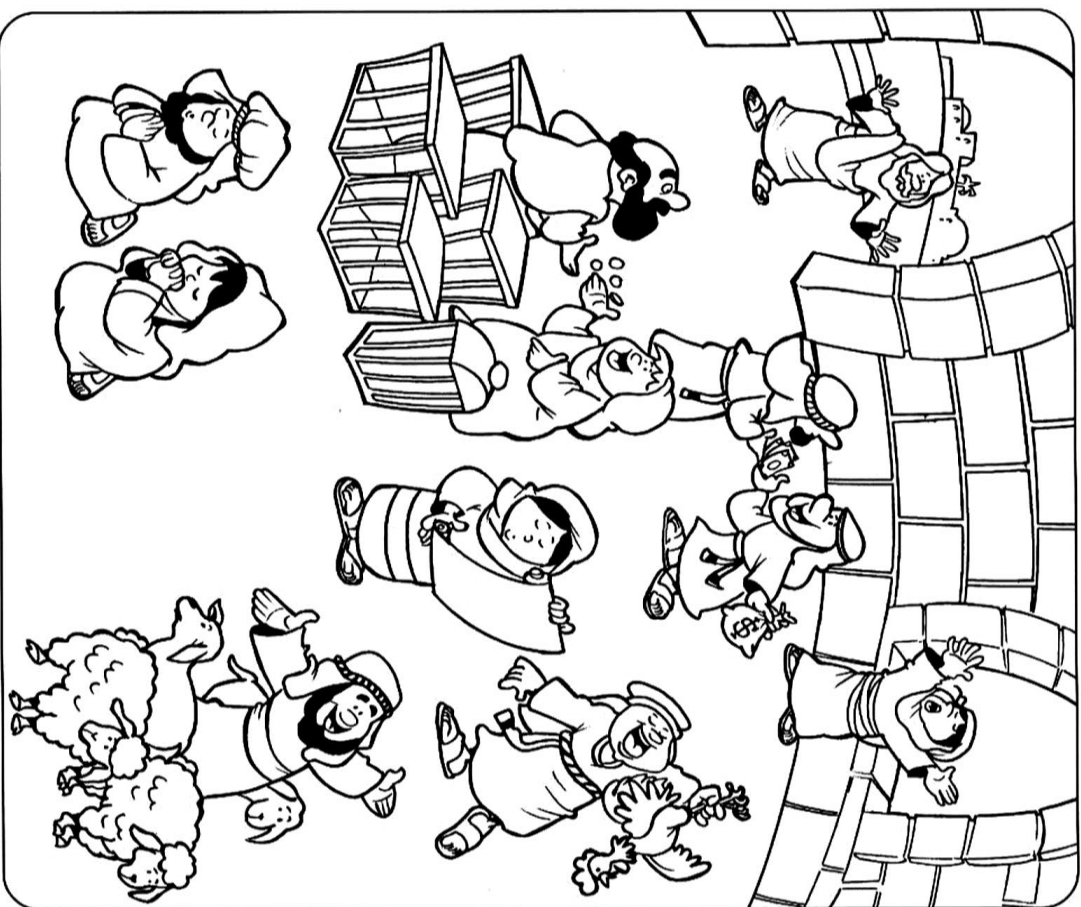
4- Jesus said "Take these things out. It is not a place to make money. It is a house of prayer."

8. The scroll is now much longer. 9. Jesus has black hair. 10. The doves are escaping.

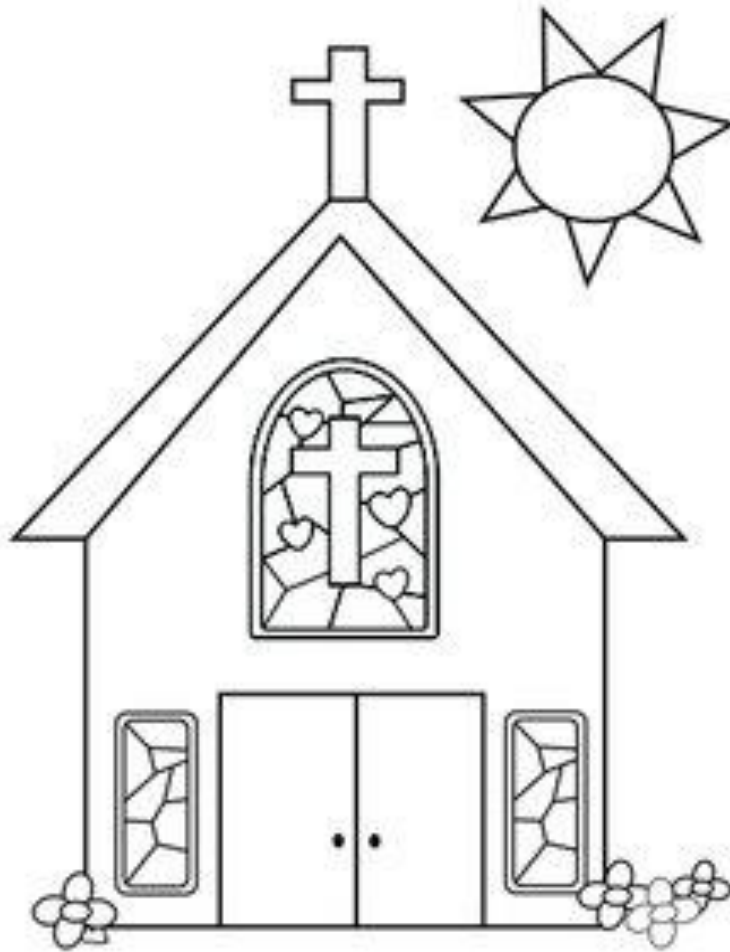

The Meaning of Good Friday



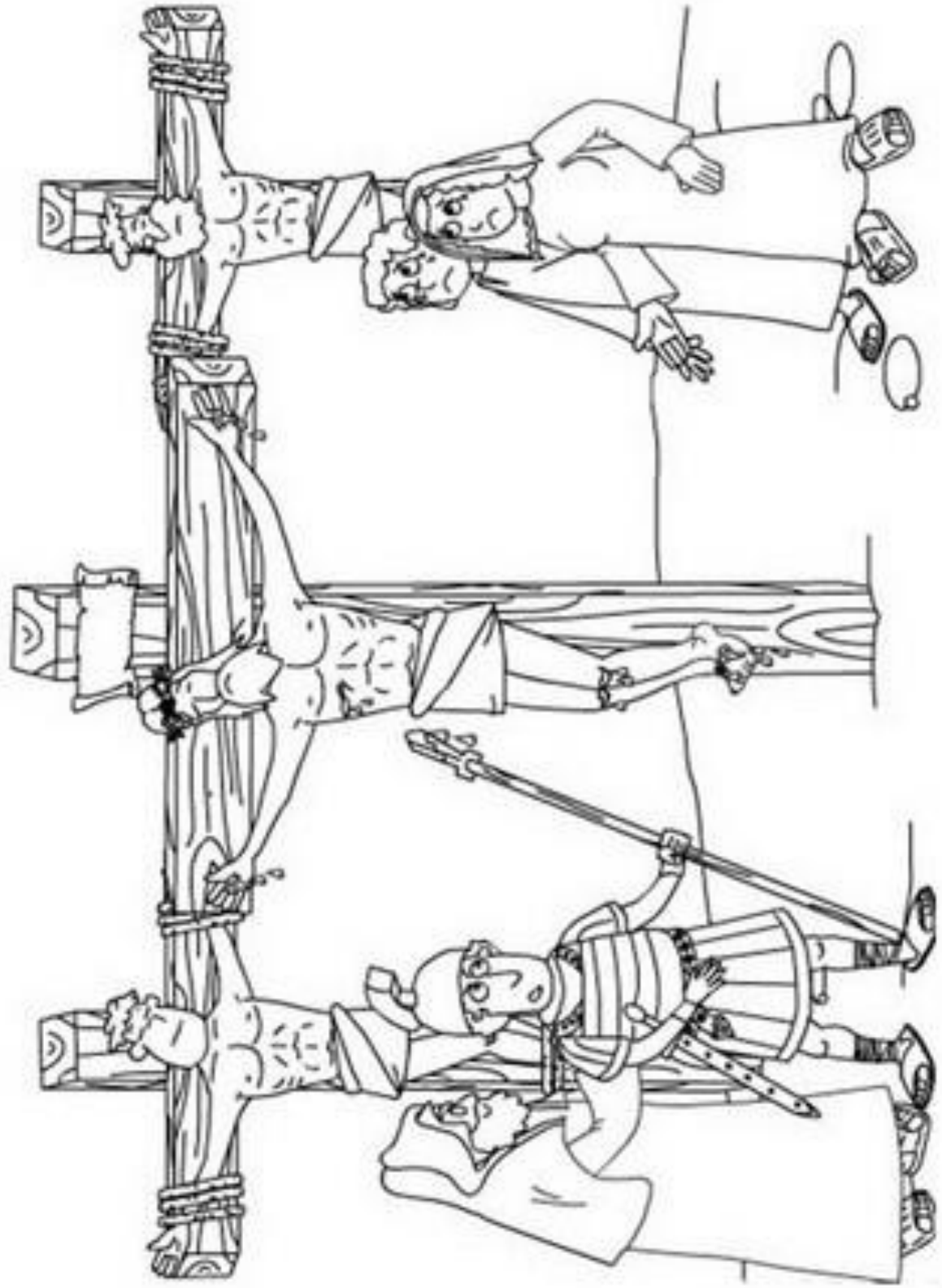

Jesus' death on the cross paid the penalty for our sins.

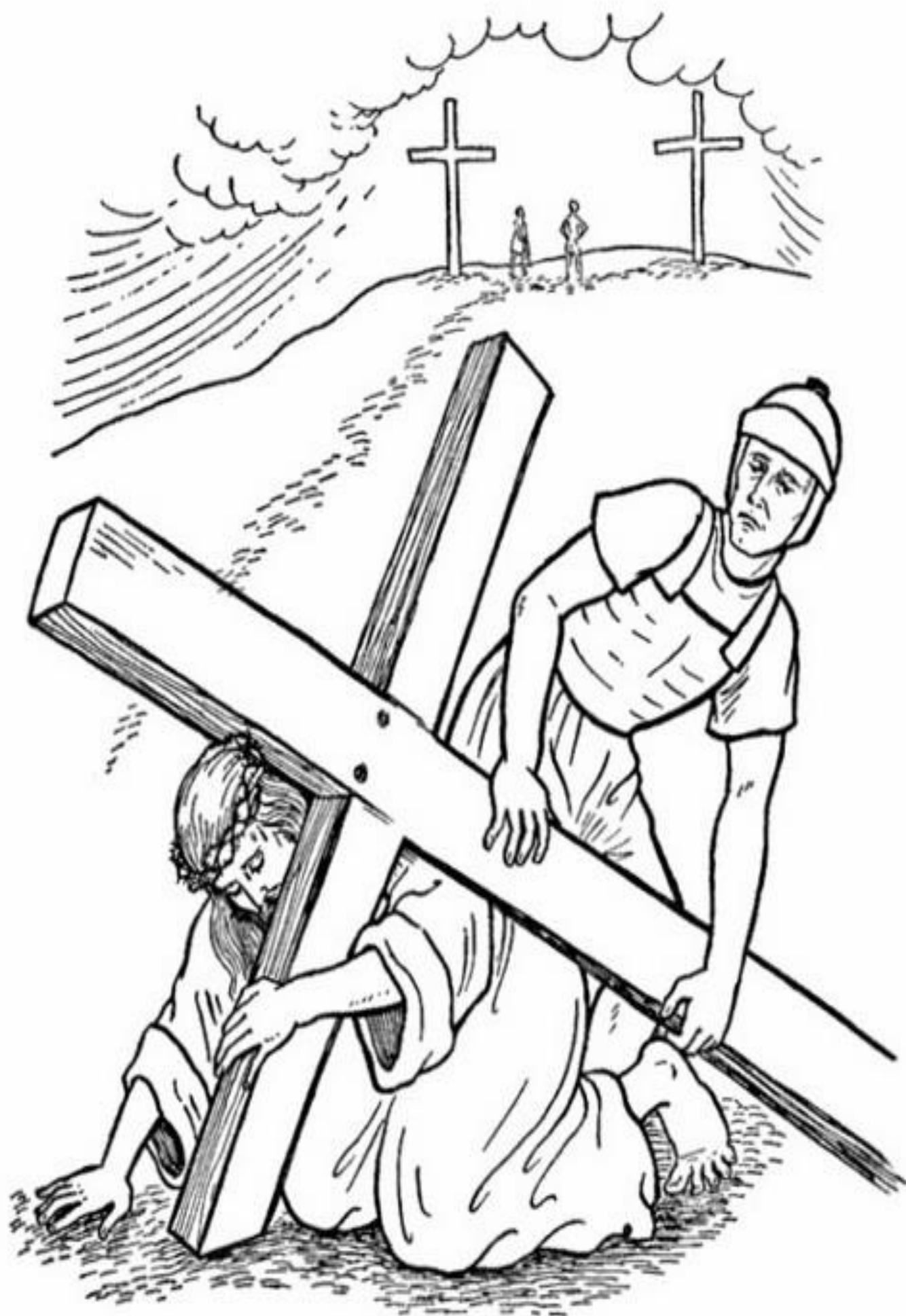
Romans 5:10 For if, when we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!

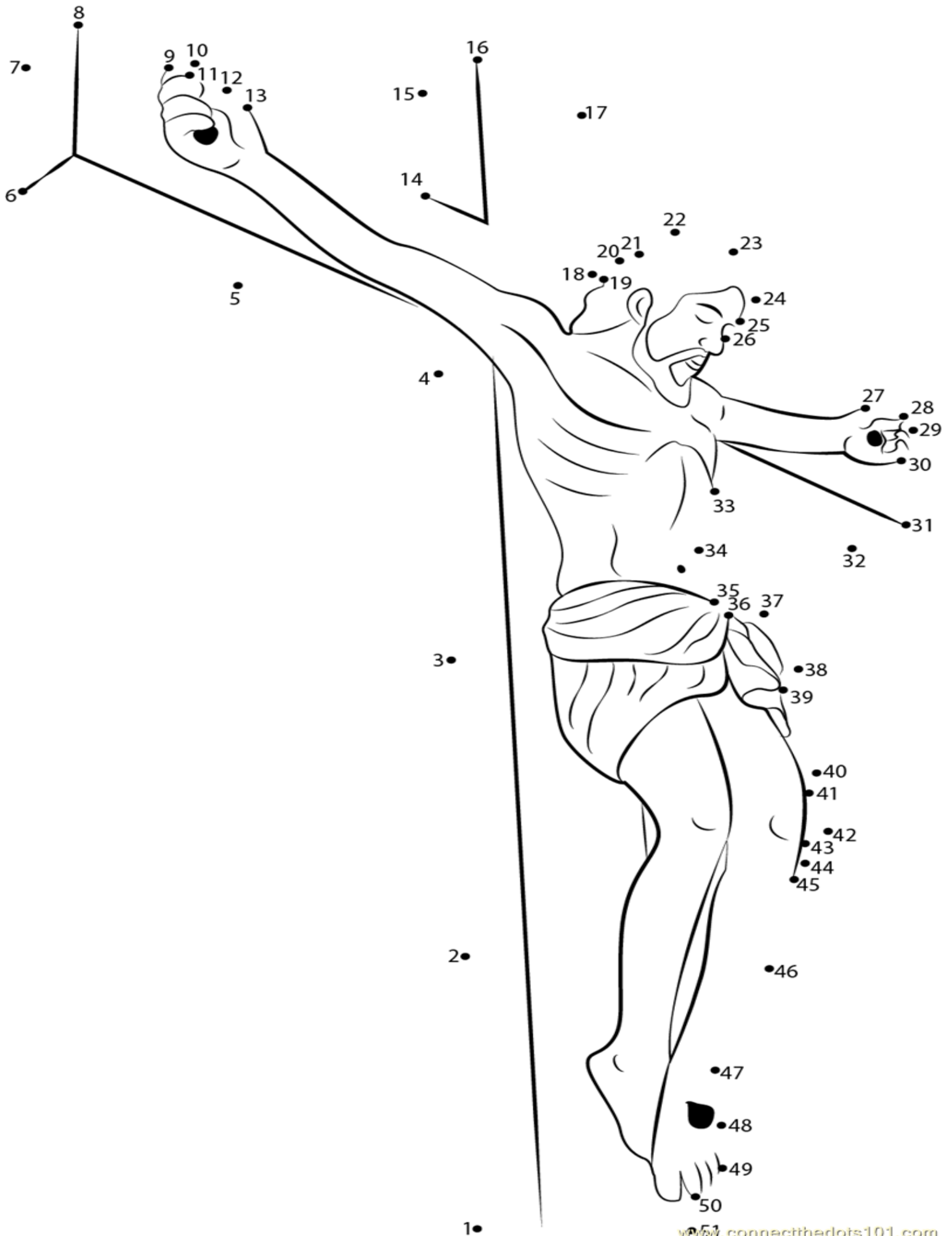


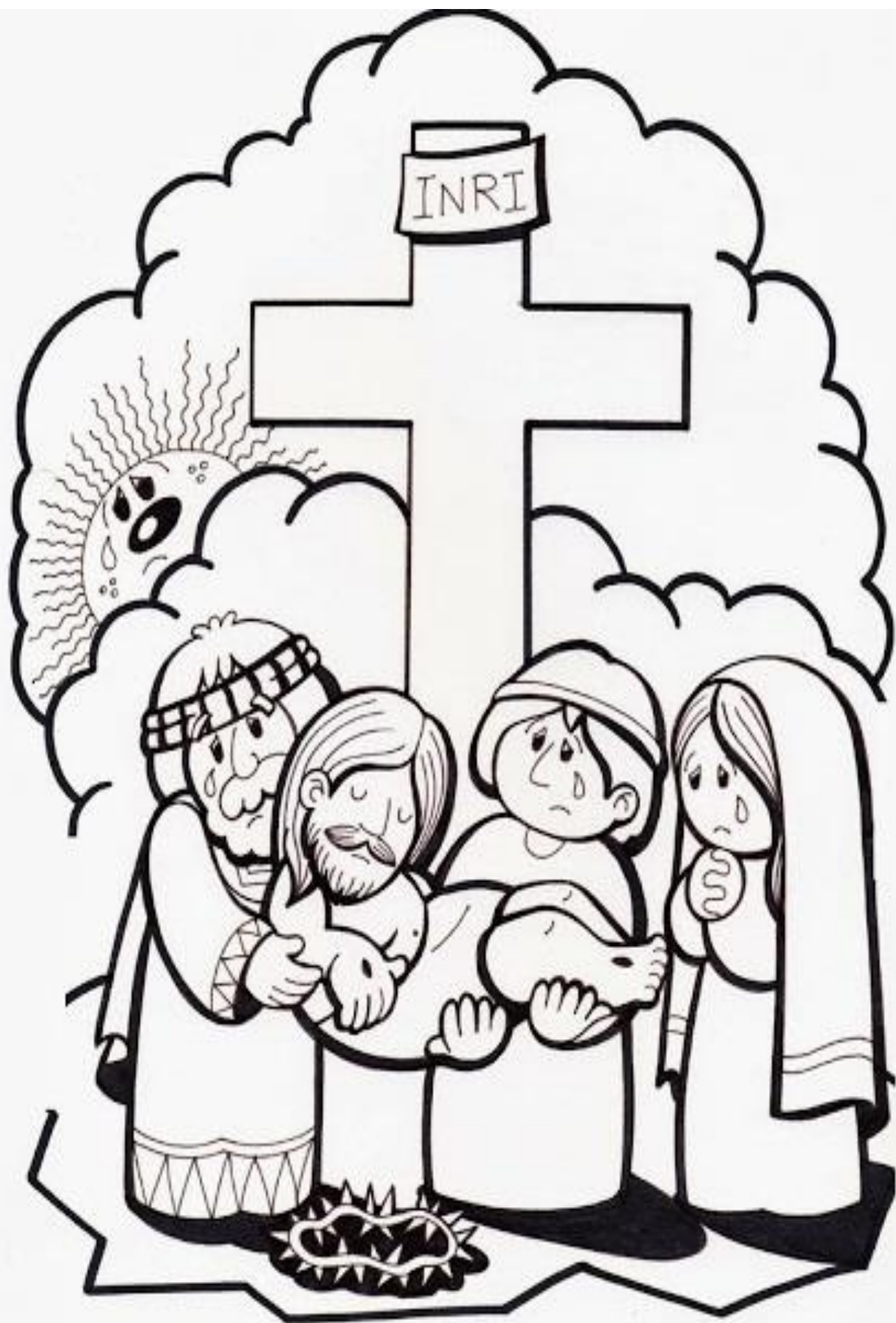




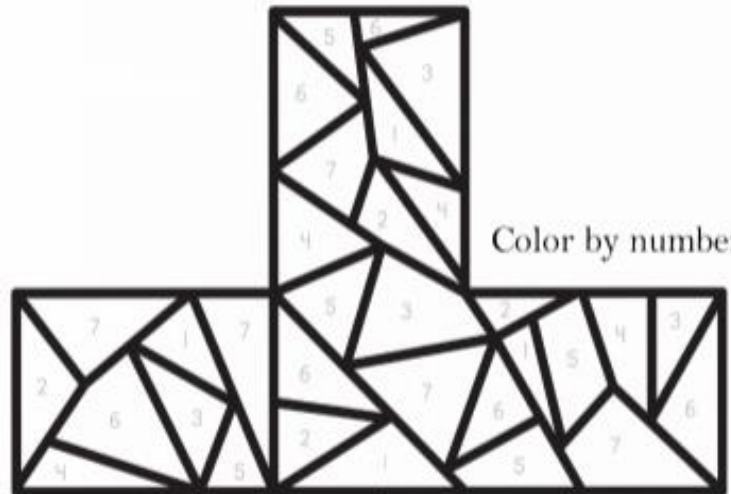
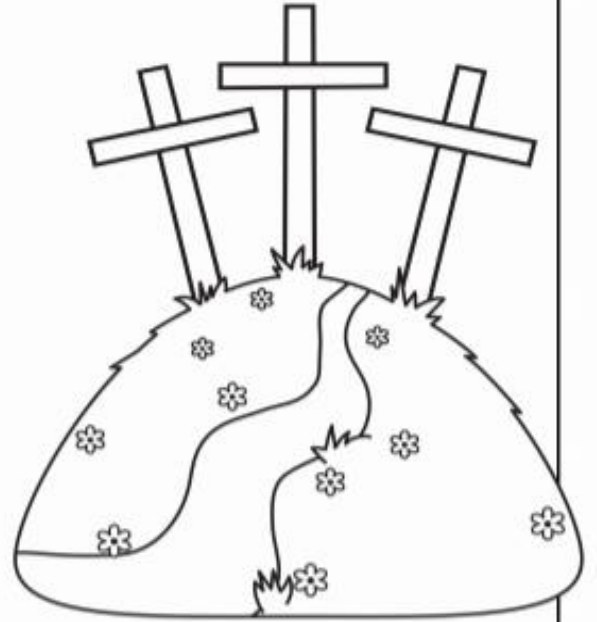
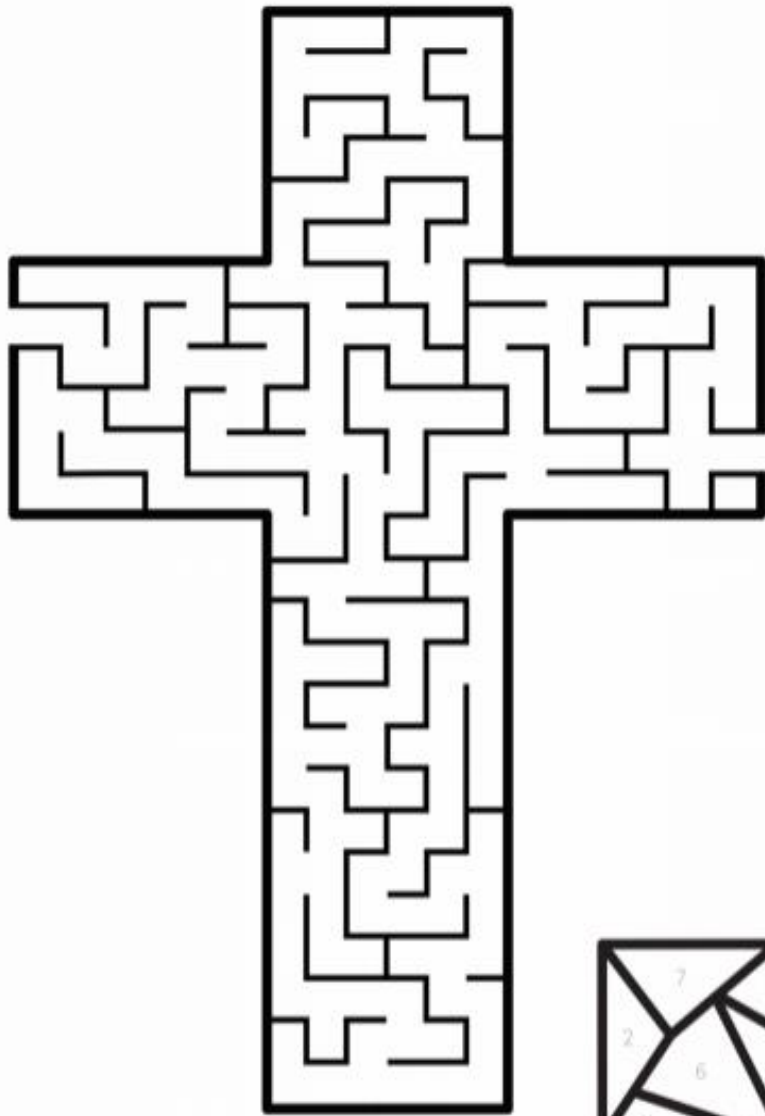








Easter Cross Maze

5 = blue

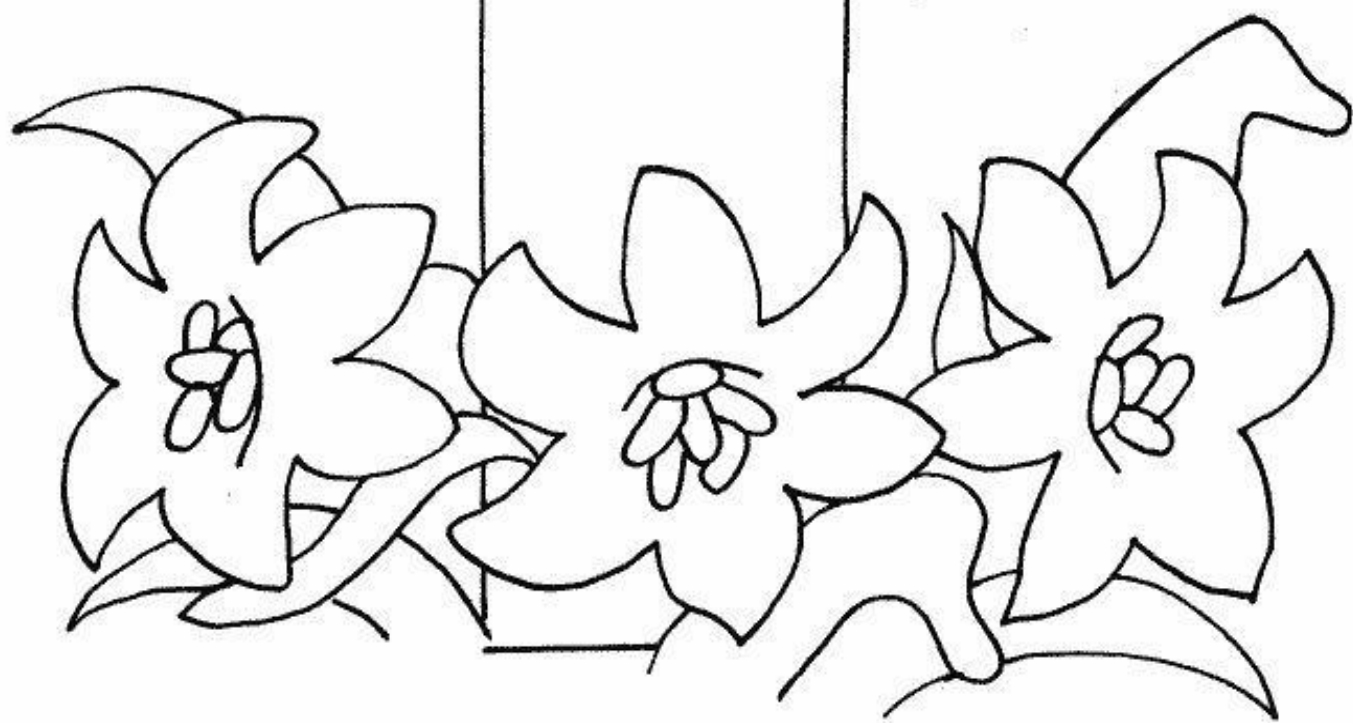

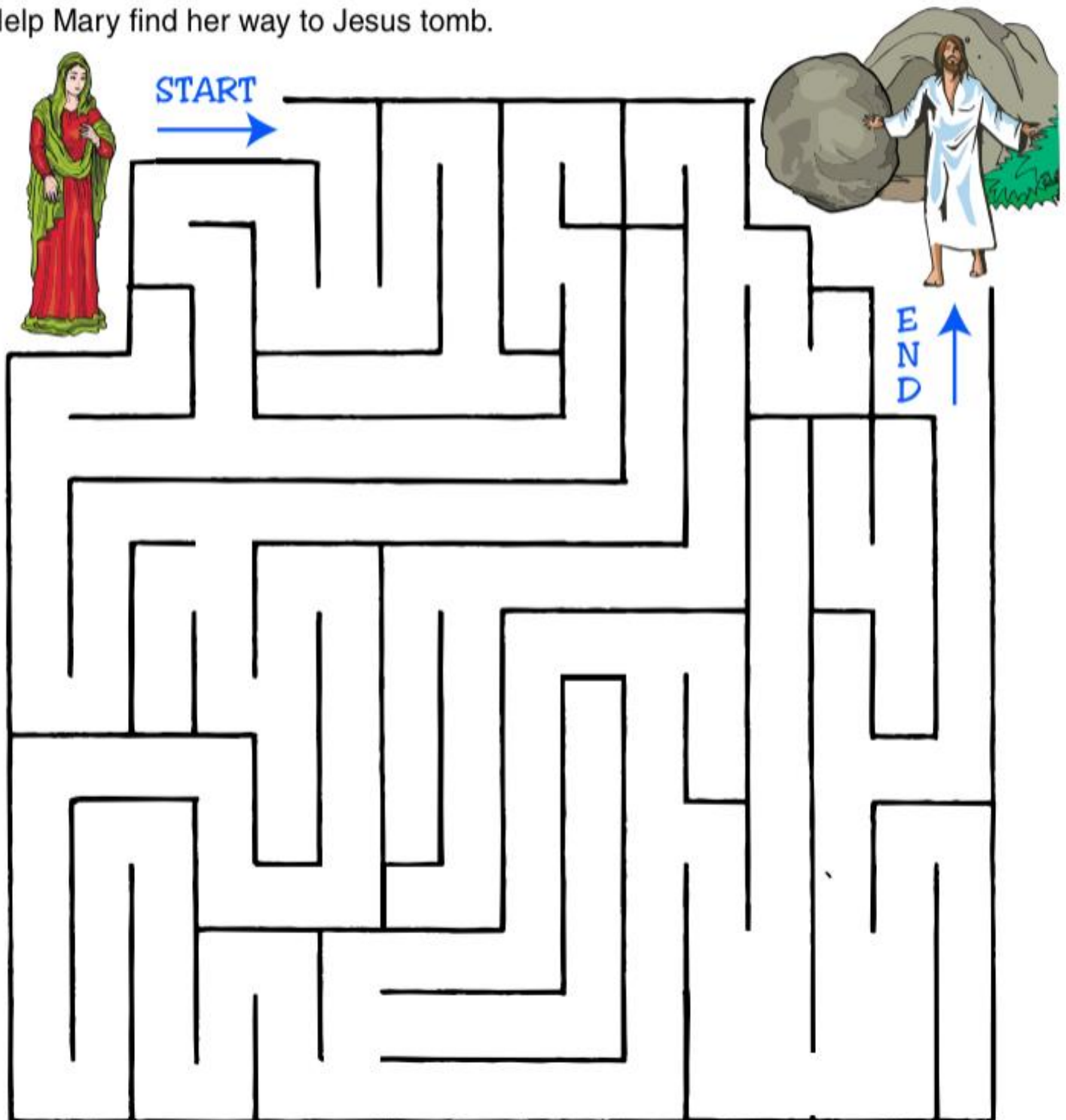


Jesus is Alive Maze

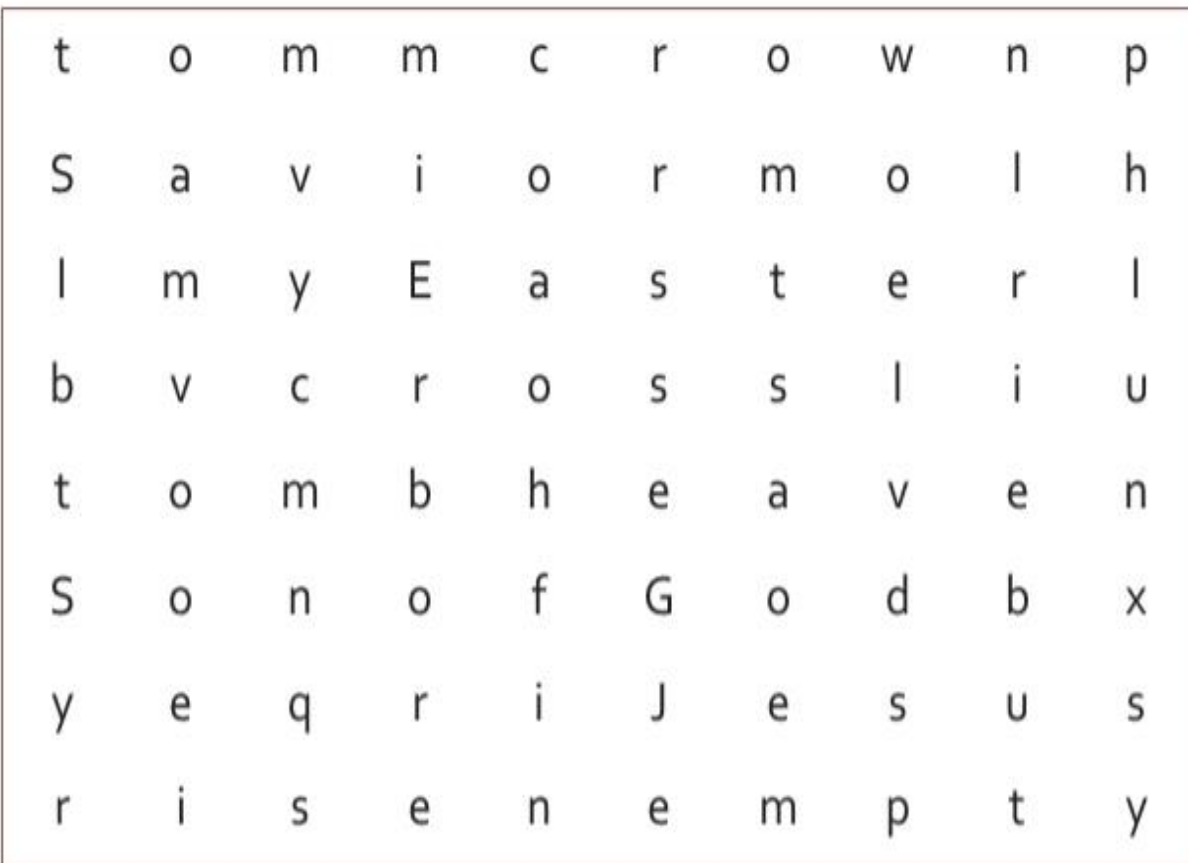
